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SHORT BIO

I am Assistant Professor in Applied Linguistics at the Cyprus University of Technology, Lemesos, Cyprus. My main area of research lies in Applied Linguistics, focusing on Computer Assisted Language Learning (CALL), L2 for Specific Academic Purposes Teaching and Learning, Curriculum Development and Evaluation, (Computer-Assisted) Language Assessment & Testing, L2 Teacher Education and eLearning.

I have a background in language learning and teacher education (Greek as a mother tongue as well as second and foreign language, English as a second language, and French and Italian as a foreign language), L2 Curriculum development and evaluation, CALL and (Computer-Assisted) Language Assessment & Testing. I have published work in international journals and conferences proceedings, taken part in EU funded as well as national funded projects, edited books and proceedings, and successfully secured EU and national funding. I am a reviewer of conference abstracts, proceedings papers, volume short papers, proceedings volumes and volumes in my research areas of interest. I am an active member of EuroCALL Association (current executive committee member and SIGs coordinator, member of two SIGs, organiser of Teacher Education Sig Seminar 2015, Conference 2016).

I am also an experienced and enthusiastic teacher, lecturing online master students with excellent feedback. I have actively set up new modules and teaching curricula at both undergraduate and postgraduate level, which are now successfully established and permanently adopted. I continuously evaluate and improve them through students' feedback and through research. Among others, these include the English for Communication and Internet Studies blended modules 1 & 2, the online MA in CALL programme, the online MA in CALL L2 Curriculum and Evaluation and L2 Assessment and Testing modules, the English for Specific Purposes Teacher Education PhD programme and the postgraduate pre-training programme for English teachers, for the Ministry of Education and Culture/University of Cyprus.

I have also given talks and presentations to both academia and primary and secondary language practitioners. In addition, I have taken leadership and managerial roles in team projects and committees, such as (a) the design, implementation and evaluation of the NEPTON test (New English Placement Test Online) for the University of Nicosia (2005), which is still used by the University, (b) the LUCIDE Languages in Urban Communities - Integration and Diversity for Europe) project, (c) the Createch Grundtvig project, Lifelong Learning Programme Grundtvig: Creativity – New Tech in Intercultural/Multilingual Education, (d) the Multilateral project Active Literacy: Competence and Understanding, Internally Naturalized (ALCUIN), Socrates Programme, Comenius 2.1 Action (Training of School Education practitioners), and CUT “Development of a Comprehensive eLearning Environment (E-Learning)” committee (2014-2016). I designed the Cyprus University of Technology (CUT) Language Centre (LC) programme and the CUT LC Research and Cooperative and Interactive Language Learning Centre (ReCILLC). I am currently participating in two such projects. I also co-organised and organised and chaired international conferences such as the EuroCALL2016 conference.

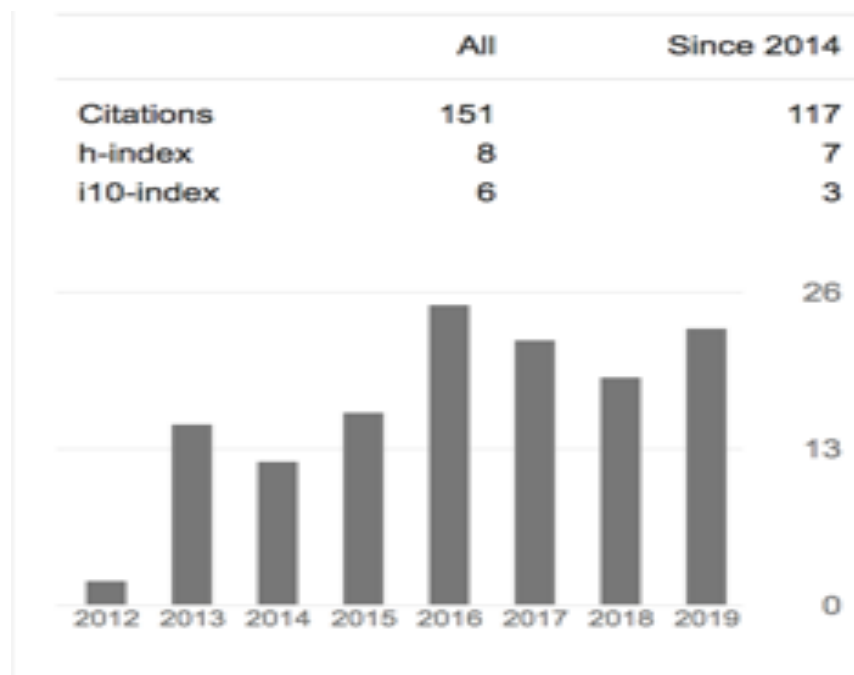
